Class Title: Projects using Jenny Haskins Designs – September 2010

Instructor: Laura Mann

Supply List & Notions Featured:

- Sewing machine in good working order, lead cord, foot control
- Embroidery unit and hoop sizes appropriate for project
- Usual sewing supplies (scissors, pins, bobbins, marking pens)
- Size 80 sharp needles
- Embroidery thread for your design (colors of your choice)
- Filled bobbins
- Fabric marking pen
- Open toe foot for your machine
- Jenny Haskins Heritage book and CD
- Jenny's Dissolve Magic or Floriani's Wet N Gone stabilizer
- Jenny's Cutaway Magic or Floriani's No Show Mesh stabilizer
- Jenny's Web Magic or Floriani's Dream Weave Fusible stabilizer
- Jenny's Invisia thread or any good polyester invisible thread (not nylon)
- Jenny's Quilt Magic lightweight fusible backing for the base block or Floriani's Heat N Sta Fleece Light
- Jenny's Tearaway Magic or Floriani's Stitch N Wash
- One (1) 15 inch square of quilter's muslin or your choice of fabric for your base backed with lightweight fusible backing
- Organza for the leaves in the color of your choice (from this organza you will need enough to embroider out three jh13 leaves)
- Organza for the petals of the flowers (you will need to cut three 1 1/2" x 50" strips) (I cut my strips about 20" long)
- Silk or cotton fabric(s) for your basket – you will need at least two – one for the basket and one for the background
- 1 yard of cream yarn (optional)

We are doing Block #5 from Jenny's Heritage book. On the CD is a pdf file for the basket foundation piecing. You will need to print this off on Tearaway Magic or Stitch N Wash stabilizer. See page 96 in the book for complete instructions on how to do this.

For class you will need to have (3) -- jh13 leaves stitched out and (3) -- jh14 flowers stitched out. You will need to have the basket foundation printed off. In class we will make our foundation basket and our decorative stitching around the basket handle. We will then continue with finishing the block. If you look at the photo or sample you will see that I did not make quite the same organza petals as Jenny did.
