Class Title: "It's A Wrap" Fabric Bowls

Instructor: Scott Farmer

Supply List & Notions Featured:

Book: "It's a Wrap" by Susan Breier, or "It's a Wrap II" by Susan Breier

Fabric: minimum of 1-1/4 yard for small bowl and lid

Cord: 3/16" x 50' poly/cotton cord preferred. 100% cotton cord will also work. (Available at K-Mart, Ace Hardware)

Fabric Glue Stick: acid free and permanent adhesive, minimum of two sticks

Thread: Your choice of cotton, cotton/polyester, monofilament. Minimum of one 300 yd spool.

Straight pins

Sewing machine needles: # 80 or #90 universal or sharps

Sewing foot: applique, zig-zag, free-motion, or open toe

Basic sewing supplies

Optional supply list:

Plexiglass extension table for sewing machine

Stiletto, bamboo skewer, or large seam ripper

Tape: blue painter's tape

Marking pen

Walking foot

Strip cutting template

Fabric glue/fray check

Before the class starts, please have enough cord wrapped to complete a small bowl and lid, usually 50' of cord. Follow the instructions in the "Basic Techniques" chapter for cutting fabric and wrapping the cord.
